# Who Is GVEALC

We are an equine-assisted therapy center that is built on a three-pronged approach of 1) providing equine-assisted therapies such as physical and occupational therapy done on horseback, and equine-assisted counseling providing social and emotional support utilizing interactions with horses, 2) being an educational facility utilizing experiential learning with horses as a modality, in addition to teaching others who want to do this line of work to be able to get certified and licensed to do so, and 3) we are a research facility that demonstrates the validity of the first two. We have been operating since 2015, at Moon Farm since July 2021, which is providing us with the growth opportunity we have been looking for.
