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

We have been working closely with the builder for our indoor arena to ensure the arena is completed before winter sets in. We have a completion date of October 31st. This indoor arena will be a major addition to our facility and therapy program, so it is essential we get it completed before winter hits. This will allow us to be able to service our clients all year round, which is something we have not been able to do since moving to this facility.
